

# JAWS and MAGic Now Available in Campus Computing Labs

The screen reader JAWS and the magnification software MAGic is now available on computers in the Hillman Library, Benedum, David Lawrence and Cathedral of Learning computer labs. JAWS will NOT be running at startup on any of the computers and therefore will not announce the log in screen. If you need the screen to be read for log-in, please see a computer lab attendant for assistance. They will assist you with log on and will then follow the steps listed below to open JAWS. An attendant can also assist you in plugging in the necessary sound output device (see below). (*Please note:* If you alter JAWS or MAGic settings during your session, please return them to default when you are finished. Specifically, do not set JAWS or MAGic to run at startup. This will interfere with the log on process for others, who are not using JAWS or MAGic.)

## **DIRECTIONS TO ACCESS JAWS:**

Log on using your username and password.  
Click on the START Menu  
Go to All Programs  
Go to Accessibility Folder  
Go to JAWS Folder  
Click on JAWS (this should launch the software)

## **DIRECTIONS TO ACCESS MAGic:**

Log on using your username and password.  
Click on the START Menu  
Go to All Programs  
Go to Accessibility Folder  
Go to the MAGic Folder  
Click on MAGic (this should launch the software)

**AS A REMINDER:** you will need to bring a headset if you are using JAWS or MAGic with the speech component enabled. Some of the computers have the headphone jack on the front panel (it is usually green), others have a grey extension cord that runs from the computer's rear panel. Most headsets used for mobile playback devices will work with the computer. Headsets used for cordless phones or cell phones likely will NOT work. If you have questions while you are trying to access either software program at any of the computing labs, ask the computer lab attendant.
